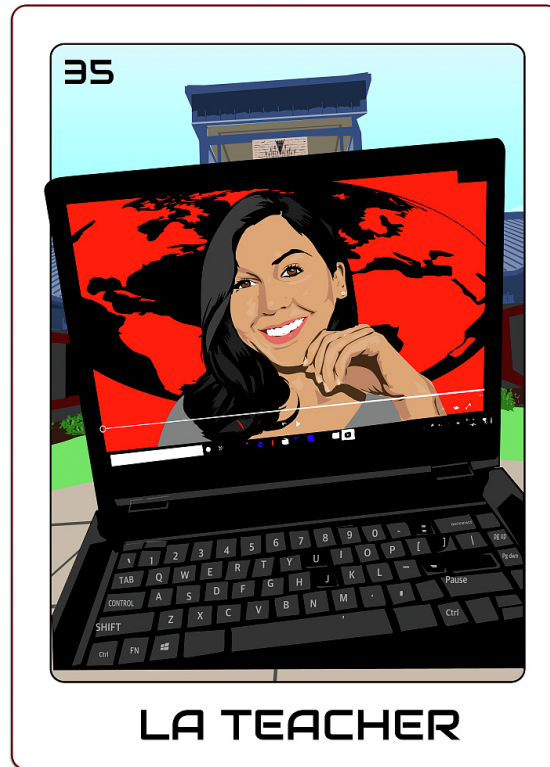
Album Description

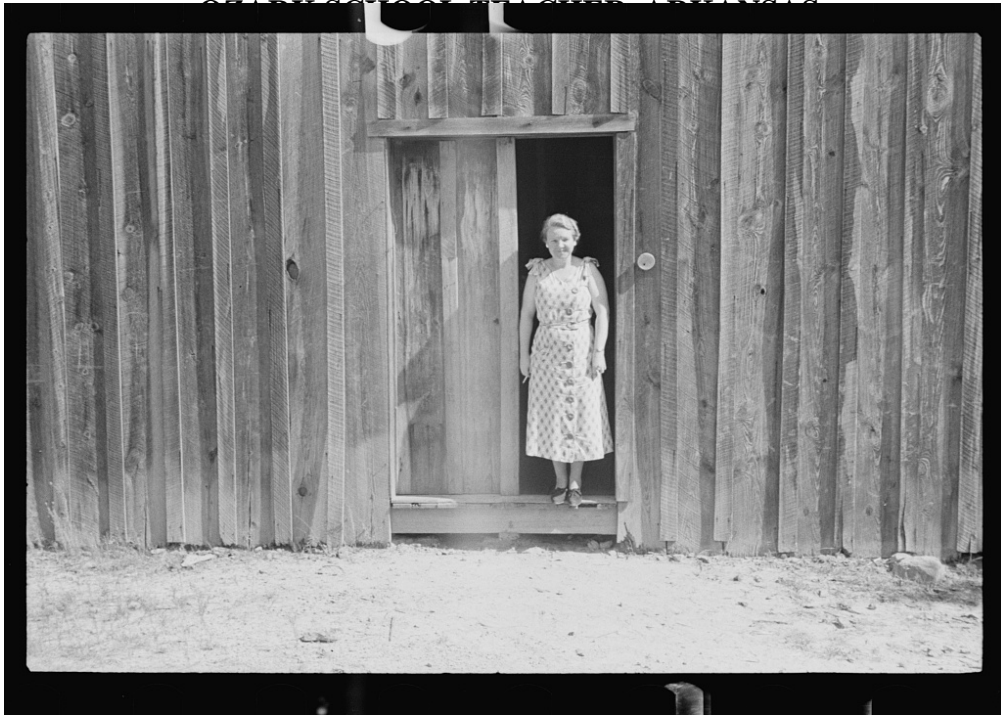

KNITTING CLASS AT A FAYETTE HOUSE KNITTING CLASS OF WOUNDED



Teaching Notes:

This 1918 photograph of a teacher showing wounded soldiers how to knit reminded me of an entry in my great grandparents' diary from the same time period. In her entry for January 25, 1918, my Great Grandmother Anna Allen wrote, "Friday: Both at home. I did housework & finished knitting a sweater for the soldier boys. took it down to Red Cross room & brought back yarn for another."

Jan 25 Friday: Both at home, I did housework & finished knitting a sweater for the soldier boys, took it down to Red Cross room & brought back yarn for another. Joe drove over after Myrtle Bates at Hill Trishes. Chilly day Mary & Tom in this eve Myrtle went home with them
