Teaching Notes:

Cup Foods, where Floyd was shot. Cadex Herrera and two other artists created the 20 X 7 mural. Herrera said noted that murals are a place for poeple to show their their respect, sop, reflect, and think and come together. Murals give us a sense of place and belonging. The center sunflower represents loyalty and life. The black center contains names of Black Americans killed during police altercations.
