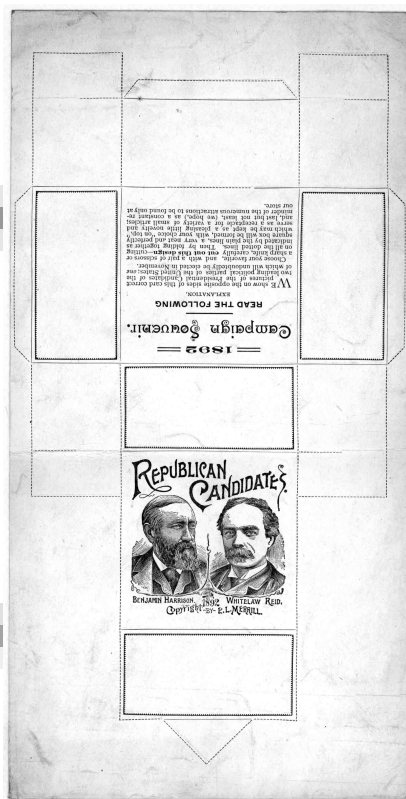
ALBUM CAMPAIGN EPHEMERA

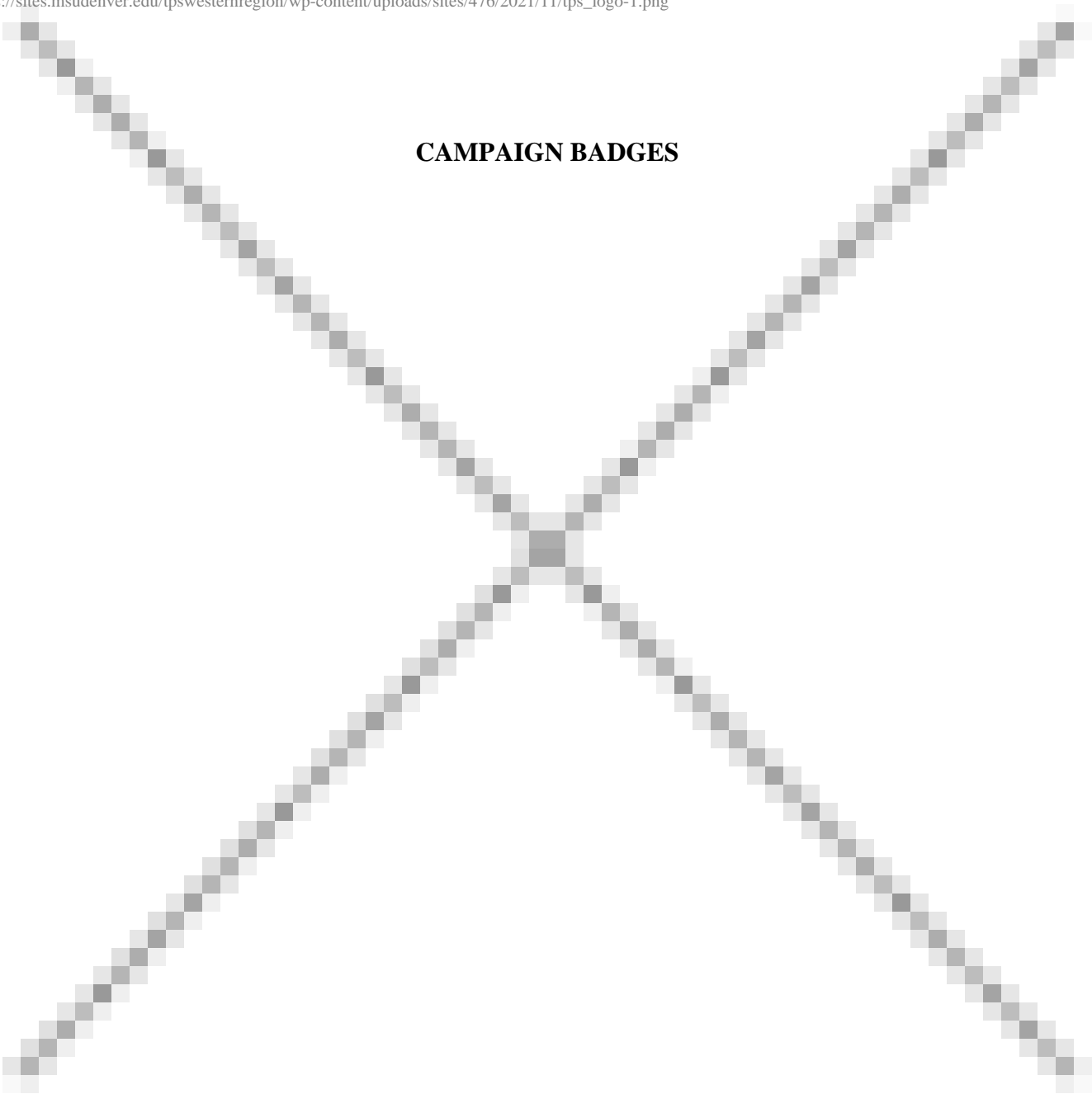

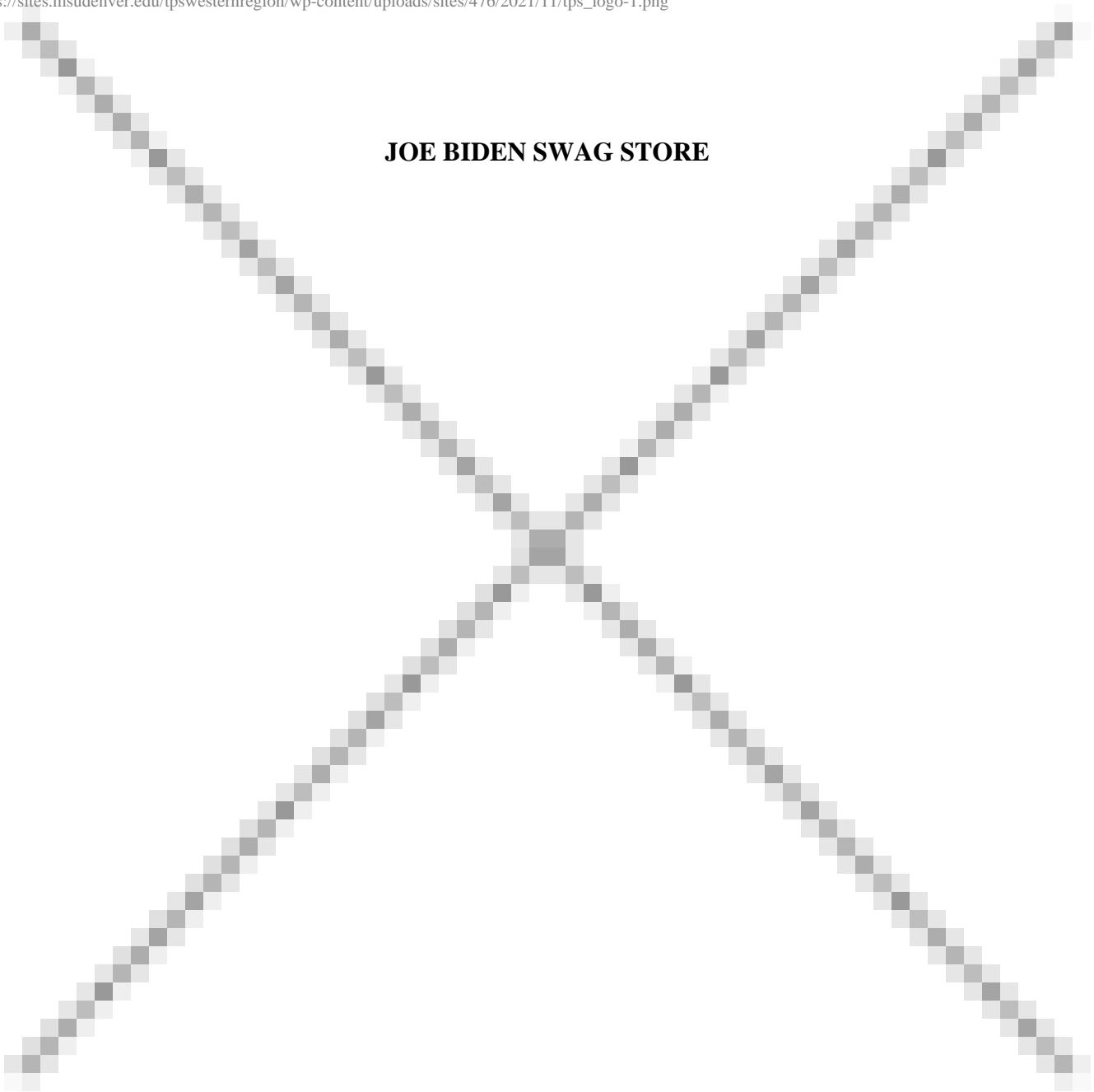

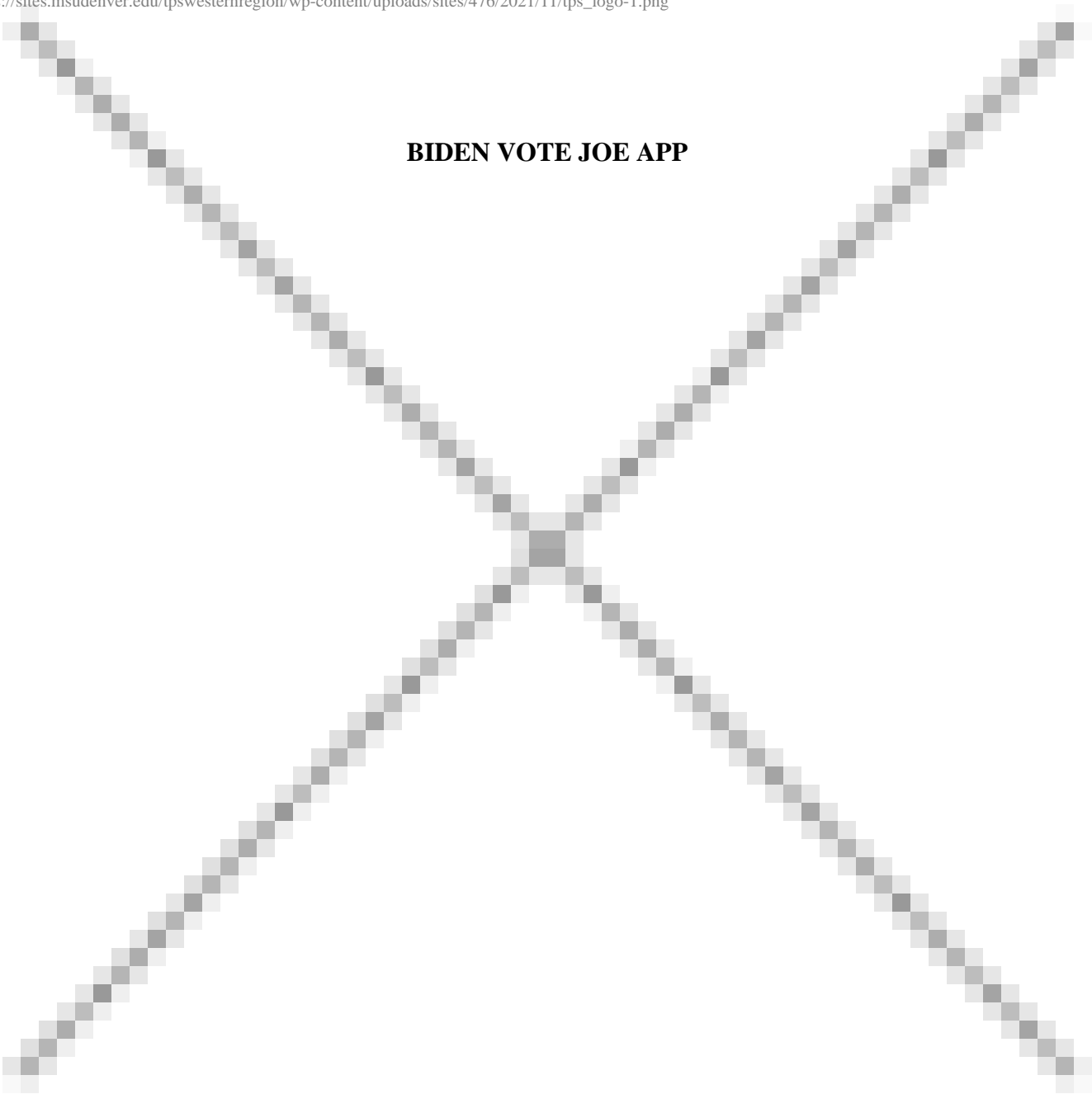

HISTORICAL CAMPAIGN BUTTONS
